After a great season we have finished top of the league and have a home play off match against Skelmanthorpe, to be announced, to see who is promoted. This is a fantastic achievement for the team and club, which has included Adam Stevens who has come through our junior ranks with others to follow I am sure.

It has been a good year financially for the club and there have been some significant improvements.
